





# Bunker Difficulties? **Skid for Success**

have many students who cringe once they enter a bunker, hoping that with some luck, they can get their golf ball out and stay on the surface of the green. A high percentage of beginner golfers have difficulty playing from bunkers as they do not understand how much sand they have to move to get the golf ball out, or make actual contact with it. Given the choice, most tour professionals prefer dealing with bunker shots as opposed to scrambling from the thick rough. Here are some helpful tips to improving your bunker play and shaving those extra strokes off your game.

- **1. Set-up is "key":** When addressing the golf ball, ensure that you play your ball position towards your left/front foot. Keep your weight more on your left-side (approximately 60-70%) and allow yourself to get into a reversed "K" posture. This will allow you to utilise the bounce of the club.
- **2. Getting the club face opened:** How often have we heard or read in magazines that your club face has to be opened at address? How many degrees open must the club face be? We would never know the exact answer and therefore, I feel the strong need to have a club face that is opened towards the target. You will adopt an opened stance but make sure that the leading edge of the club is perpendicular to the target as shown in the diagram.
- **3. The Execution:** Keep your weight on your left-side throughout the swing and be sure to have your belt-buckle facing the target through impact. It is important to prevent the hips from stalling on the through-swing.
- **4. Skid for success:** Using the bounce of the club and not the leading edge, accelerate through the sand and keep your club face square through impact. In Dave Pelz's, "*Shortgame Bible*", studies have shown that one should hit through the sand approximately two inches behind the ball. Note that there should not be any releasing (closing) of the club face at this point. Get a feel of using the bounce of the club to "skid" through the sand instead of "dig".

# Golf 101 Ball Resting Against Flagstick

# **Scenario:**

When a player's ball rests against the flagstick in the hole and the ball is not holed, the player must remove the flagstick and if the ball falls into the hole, the player is deemed to have holed out with his last stroke.



### Scenario 1

### Solution:

The player should remove the flagstick and if the ball falls into the hole, the player is deemed to have holed out with his last stroke.





# Scenario 2

# **Solution:**

A player's ball is resting against the flagstick, but it is not holed because all of it is not below the level of the lip of the hole. The player then picks the ball up thinking that the ball is holed.

Hint: A ball is "holed" when it is at rest within the circumference of the hole and all of it is below the level of the lip of the hole.
