To accommodate the final phase of land return, holes #16 and #17 which are closely located to the existing boundary line will undergo reconfiguration from 1 Aug 2018 – 31 Jan 2019.

The club will also seize this opportunity to re-grass holes #13, #14 and #15, which will improve conditions of the playing turf.

During this reconfiguration work, members can expect full 18-holes at all times. However, minor disruptions can be expected and the club will endeavour to minimise this to the maximum extent possible.

Once again, thanks for your support for Charity Golf 2018 and happy golfing!

Changes in Course Markings

In this second part of a two-part special, we look at changes in course markings made on Hole 3 of our new front 9. These changes, in response to golfers' feedback to the Greens Committee, are implemented with the main intention of making the course more playable and enjoyable by reducing ambiguity should a player's ball end up where it is not intended to go.

Hole 3

BEFORE

Red stakes that surround the bridge could be interpreted as the bridge and stairs not being inside the lateral water hazard.






AFTER

Red lines have been added to give clarity as to the intended area of the stairs and bridge being inside the lateral water hazard. When there are both stakes and lines, the stakes identify the hazard and the lines define the hazard margin (See definition of Water Hazard). The line on the ground is itself inside the water hazard, so as long as a ball touches the line, it is considered inside. The stakes which identify the hazard are obstructions, and in NSRCC, we deem them to be immovable obstructions so if a player's ball is not in the hazard and the intended area of swing or stance suffers interference, please do not remove the stake as you are entitled to free relief.










Reconfiguration of Holes #16 and #17 at NSRCC Changi

ack in 2014, the Club had announced that the expansion of Changi Airport and proposed road works would affect our golf courses at Changi. This was followed with extensive reconfiguration efforts to ensure the remaining facilities continue to serve members well.

In the original blue print for land return, a very small plot of land bordering Changi hole #16 will be affected in late 2019. This will mark the completion of the land return plan announced back in 2014. Therefore, the Club will carry out the necessary reconfiguration works at holes #16 and #17 from Aug 1 2018 – Jan 31 2019 to effect the change in land configuration.


Area of Land to be returned to the State



The existing plot of land where hole #16 is within close proximity to the designated area of land which will be returned to the State. Both holes #16 and #17 will need to be realigned, as the existing boundary lines will be shifted inwards, forcing #16 to encroach onto the area occupied by #17. The reconfiguration of both holes #16 and #17 will be carried out from from Aug 1 2018 – Jan 31 2019.

Temporary Line of Play during Reconfiguration Process



The golf course will continue to remain 18-holes playable throughout the entire reconfiguration period. Temporary greens/tees will be constructed for both holes #16 and #17. The diagram highlights specific areas of the on-going construction and also indicates the temporary line of play.

Hole #16 will be played as a Par-3 hole, and Hole #17 will be played as a shorter Par-4 during the on-going reconfiguration.

New Layout of Holes #16 & #17



The reconfigured holes #16 and #17 are scheduled to be opened for play on 1 Feb 2019. The diagram indicates the new layout of holes #16 and #17, following the reduction of the existing boundary line and the completion of the reconfiguration process. Holes #16 and #17 will continue to play as a Par-4, while the 10th tee remains as par 36. In brief, the distance at hole #16 will be shorter by about 50 meters, and the distance of hole #17 will remain about the same, as per before reconfiguration.

Re-turfing of Holes #13, #14 and #15

The Club will take the opportunity in carrying out a major re-turfing exercise at hole #13, #14 and #15 during the reconfiguration process. Some benefits include better playability and smoother turf surfaces. With good turf density, mowing heights can easily be reduced to allow faster green speed.

For the other holes at tenth tee, the Club will carry out turf replacement exercise progressively at later time, in order to bring the turf condition of tenth tee on par with first tee.

There will be some inconvenience to on-going golf games, as only part of the greens will be blocked off and works carried out in the night. Do look out for the affected areas marked with "G.U.R." sign. The Club seeks your understanding and cooperation during the reconfiguration period, and will endeavour to keep the disruptions at a minimal, for members to continue enjoying their golf.

Important Information for Members

- The 6-month reconfiguration process will commence from 1 Aug 2018 till 31 Jan 2019, and resume normal play from 1 Feb 2019.
- The existing boundary line will be reduced to facilitate the land return, and holes #16 and #17 will be re-adjusted.
- Hole #16 will be temporarily played as a Par-3.
- Hole #17 will be temporarily played as a shorter Par-4.
- Throughout the entire reconfiguration & re-turfing process, the golf course will remain 18-holes playable.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q1. When will the reconfiguration of holes #16 and #17 commence and complete?

The reconfiguration process will commence from 1 Aug 2018 and complete by 31 Jan 2019.

Q2. Will the Club be required to return any more land to the state?

There is no indication of any more land return after the 2014 announcement.

Q3. Hole #16 sits on the land closer to the existing boundary line, so why is there a need for Hole #17 to also undergo reconfiguration?

To facilitate with the land return, the existing boundary lines will be shifted inwards towards hole #16. This will in turn affect the existing layout of hole #17 and will therefore require realignment.

Q4. How will the golf course at Changi remain 18-holes playable, when both holes #16 and #17 will be reconfigured?

Temporary greens/tees will be constructed at both holes #16 and #17, to ensure that we are able to provide an 18-holes playable course at all times to our members.

Q5. Why only re-turf holes #13, #14 and #15, what about #10, #11, #12, and #18?

The #13, #14, and #15 are in a condition that requires major re-turfing soon. The conditions of the other holes are less severe and will be rectified at a later time progressively.
