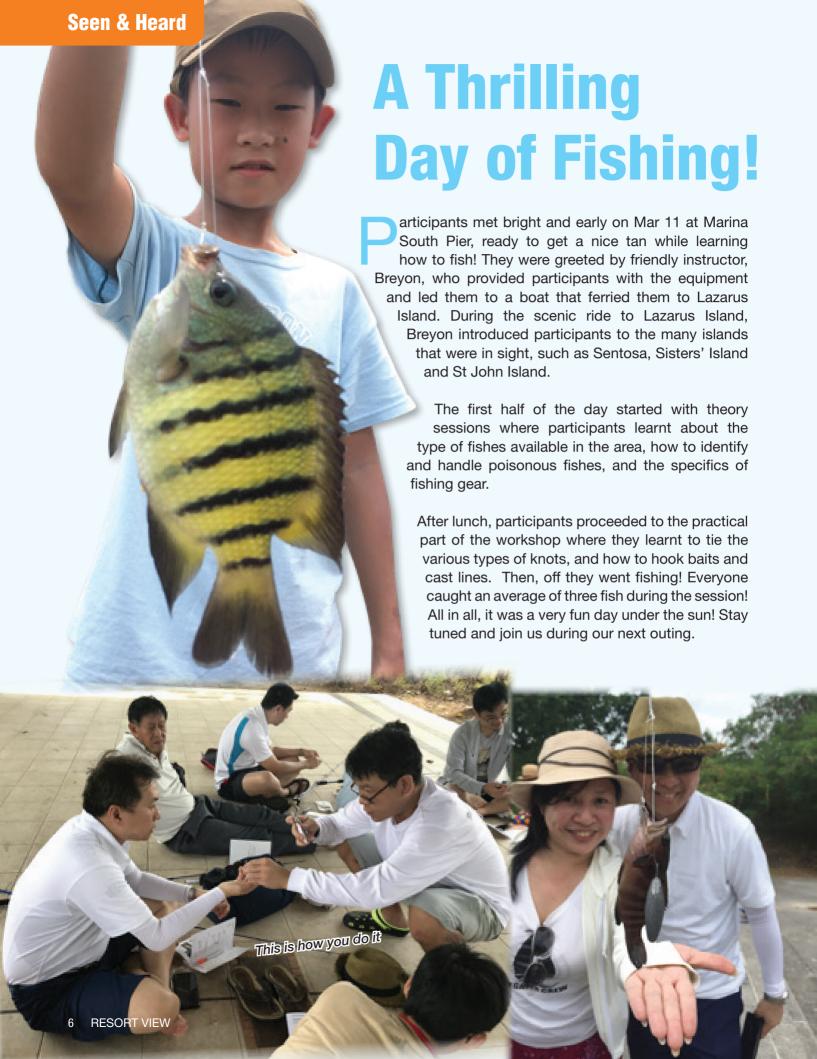

Change to Golf Course Maintenance Day at **NSRCC Kranji**

Golfers' will be pleased to know that there will be changes to the Golf Course Maintenance Day for NSRCC Kranji. Our current closures are either half or full day for 9-holes, which limits your Tuesday games to be played on 9-holes twice. The Club will implement a 3-month trial on the changes to Course Maintenance Schedule starting from May till July 2018.

This new maintenance schedule will now allow golfers' the full 18-hole experience every alternate

Tuesdays and also allows our Course Maintenance Crew to execute needed maintenance works on all 18-holes at once. Mizuno Golf School Finding an Intermediate



Target

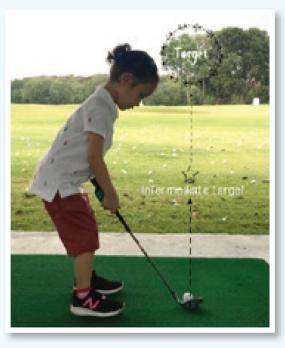

question I frequently hear when I am at the driving range is, "Where are you aiming?" Do golfers really work on their targeting or aiming at the driving range? Do they have a specific target to aim at when they practise? As a golfer myself, I never really bothered about choosing a specific target because the range is so wide open. But let's imagine the driving range as the golf course.

Would selecting a target to aim be important on the golf course? Without a doubt the answer is yes because if we don't aim properly, we would probably end up with a lot of tough shots and may be penalized for missing the ideal landing areas. It is something we may not realise, but range practice should be as close as possible to playing on the golf course. It should also include accuracy in selecting targets / aim training.

Do you find it easy to aim before every shot? How many out of 10 times does the ball go to that specific target? Misjudged targets or a misperception of it can cause a swing error so do place importance on your aim direction and practise with effectiveness and purpose.

There are two players that I know of who have a good way of aiming. Can you guess who they might be? They are legends and have won many majors. They are none other than Tiger Woods and Jack Nicklaus. They have a good routine in aiming. In the process of aiming, they make use of an intermediate target.



Finding an Intermediate Target

How to Find an Intermediate Target

- 1. Stand behind the ball and choose a target.
- 2. After choosing a target, draw an imaginary line all the way to a spot (1 metre away) from where you address.
- 3. Find an obvious spot that lines up with the distant target. This spot is called your intermediate target.
- 4. As you prepare to aim, align your hips, your feet, your shoulders and eyes parallel to the intermediate target and align your clubface to the intermediate target.

Having an intermediate target will make aiming much easier and accurate. So, the next time when you are on the range, do practise this for every shot and this will help to lower your scores and improve your aim and direction. With the right aim, it will lead to better scores!

GILE 101

Changes in Course Marking

In this two-part special, we look at some changes in course markings made on Holes 2 and 3 of our new front 9, and in this edition we will focus on Hole 2. These changes are the result of golfers' feedback to the Greens Committee and after deliberation and consideration, are implemented with the main intention to make the course more playable and enjoyable and reduce ambiguity should a players' ball end up where it usually isn't intended to go.

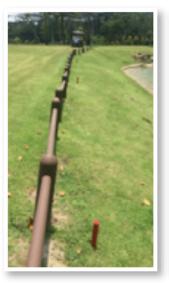




Hole 2

Before: Red stakes marking the lateral water hazard on the entire left of the length of the hole were previously placed next to the water. This resulted in players still having to make a drop and taking the next shot on the steep slopes leading to the water even after maximizing the 2 club length relief area.

After: Red stakes moved up closer to the fairway. Thus if a player's ball enters the lateral water hazard, the 2 club length dropping area now is on flat ground. If a player's ball lies on the slope within the hazard lines, they still have the option to play the ball as it lies.





The lateral water hazard line is just before the wooden barriers (immovable obstruction), thus the wooden barriers are not inside the lateral water hazard.

If a player's ball is not inside the lateral water hazard and his area of intended swing or stance suffers interference from the wooden barriers, free relief is afforded. If however a player's ball is inside the water hazard and the area of intended swing or stance suffers interference from the wooden barriers, there is no free relief (Rule 24-2b). The player may then play the ball as he likes, like chip it out, or take relief from the lateral water hazard as usual and get 2 club length relief (Rule 26-1c) amongst the usual other options.
