NATIONAL SERVICE RESORT & COUNTRY CLUB TERMS OF COMPETITON (TOC)

RULES OF PLAY

The competition shall be played over 18 holes in accordance with the Rules of Golf currently adopted by the R & A and the United States Golf Association (USGA) and the Local Rules of NSRCC.

All complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred immediately to the Tournament Director, whose decision shall be final.

FORMAT OF PLAY

The competition shall be played over 18 holes and the scoring shall be based on Strokeplay or Stableford as specified. All participants shall play off 100% of his or her handicap. In the event of a tie, the NSRCC countback system shall be used to determine the winner.

DIVISION

There shall be Six divisions:-

A Division (Men)	-	Handicap Index < 7.0 (less than 7.0)
B Division (Men)	-	Handicap Index 7.1 – 11.0
C Division (Men)	-	Handicap Index 11.1 – 18.0
D Division (Men)	-	Handicap Index 18.1 – 24.4
Ladies A Division	-	Handicap Index < 11.0 (less than 11.0)
Ladies B Division	-	Handicap Index 11.1 – 36.4

All competitors shall play off their handicaps as at closing date. If a player handicap is revised before the closing date of the tournament, he or she shall play off the revised handicap. Participants who belong to more than one golf club must play off the lowest handicap held.

DATE AND TIME

The competition shall be played at the Location as specified.

All competitors must report to the Registration Table at least 15 minutes before their tee-off time. Any competitor who is late shall be subject to the appropriate penalty under the Rules of Golf.

Competitors shall tee-off in the order of the draw. No substitution or mutual change of tee-off times shall be permitted.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to members with handicaps maintained by NSRCC or Clubs associated with the Singapore Golf Association (SGA) and who are amateurs in accordance with the R & A's and USGA's Rules of Amateur Status and who have a current handicap of 24.4 or less for men and 36.4 or less for ladies.

Members with handicaps maintained by Malaysian, Indonesian and other overseas golf clubs are not eligible to participate in this competition.

The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without assigning any reason for such rejection.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee per competitor is **\$80.00** for Member, **\$132** for Basic Member + GST and is inclusive of green and buggy fees.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

Entry shall close on the date as specified.

NO-SHOW BY COMPETITOR

A competitor in any competition who fails to appear (No-Show) on the starting tee at the appointed time or when called, shall be disqualified and his entrance fee shall be forfeited and a surcharge equivalent to the amount of the green fees be further imposed and he shall be precluded for a period of 60 days from entering any competition of the Club.

CANCELLATION BY COMPETITOR

Any cancellation request received from a competitor 72 hours prior to the start of event WILL NOT BE subjected to any cancellation fee.

Any cancellation request received from a competitor WITHIN 72 hours from the start of the event WILL BE subjected to cancellation fee. The club reserves the right to impose an additional surcharge equivalent to the amount of the green fees and he shall be precluded for a period of 60 days from entering any competition of the Club.

Please note that the competitor's name will be removed from the draw list and is not eligible to convert this flight or slot to social play.

CANCELLATION BY CLUB

Should a competition have incomplete/insufficient entries, (less than 8 players in any Division for both Men's and Ladies), the Tournament Director may postpone or cancel the competition as deemed fit. In the event of a cancellation by the Club, competitors WILL NOT be charged the entrance fee for the event and will be notified of the cancellation at least 48 hours prior to the event. Competitors affected will be allowed to maintain their tee time slots for social play.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather resulting in the inability of the field to complete play, the competition will be deem as valid if two-third of the field has completed and the results of the competition shall be based on the scores returned. The Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel the tournament.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE

The use of devices that measure only distance is permitted. A player is not permitted to carry or use devices that measure other conditions which might affect the play of the game.

SLOW PLAY

The attention of all competitors is drawn to Rule 5-6 regarding slow play. The Committee will not hesitate to impose penalties under this rule.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the Best Gross for Strokeplay or Best Points for Stableford. All prizes must be collected personally. Prizes not collected after 3 months will be forfeited.

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to revise the rules and regulations.
